This is a region with many security problems, a boss including the insurrection of Boko Haram. In the North Central region, Mandrian militancy has become a key security concern. Northwest Nigeria, who was the bastion of security and stability, was hit hard from the rural bandit. I have explored this situation and its operational threat in my research. The rural banditry refers to the armed violence guided mainly by the criminal intent to steal and loot. It is motivated by the search for economic accumulation. The victims are individuals and communities with material value objects. The most common examples of rural banditry in Nigeria are the armed robbery, kidnapping, rustling cattle and village raids. Rural banditry in the north-western states of Zamfara, Kaduna and Katsina reached alarming heights in recent years. The bandits terrorize the villages with impunity. They actually established themselves in the state of the zamfara, creating fortified enclaves in the hinterland and borders, from where they take and carry out their operations. What does the rural banditry guide? The crime thrives in the contexts in which there is a small deterrence. In most rural Nigeria communities, there are many opportunities for the criminal activity. For one thing, some of these communities are found in remote areas where there is little or no government presence. More importantly, families are in some cases separated from and interspersed with forest areas. This makes them vulnerable to the banditry. This situation has worsened with the absence of effective community police mechanisms able to address the particular challenges of Enterlands security. In fact, the incidence and prevalence of the rural bandit in the north-west of Nigeria raise a fundamental question on the capacity of the government to govern effectively. State security machinery has so far not succeeded in facing the banditry scourge. This failure derives from a lack of political volunteer and operational challenges. In essence, the prevailing socio-existential conditions in the North-Western Nigeria complicated the security situation. The rural pastoral sector is not well regulated. Even the illicit artisan extraction and the proliferation of weapons in the region are also true factors. Geography also plays a role. Northwestern forests of Nigeria are vast, robust and dangerous. They are also coarsely under-policed. Some of the forests run next to the different porous border lines on the frontiers of the region. The borders are Outlined, under-policed â €
